Healey IRF & Engineers Without Borders -- Clinic Assessments

At the invitation of the Healey International Relief Foundation (Healey IRF), Engineers Without Borders-PA Lehigh Chapter travelled to Sierra Leone to conduct engineering assessments at two clinics in the Healey IRF Charity Health Network. Stella Maris and St. Anthony's Clinic are both located in Freetown and serve a catchment area of approximately 50,000 and treat nearly 1,200 patients per month. Expansion and structural improvement of both clinics are a high priority for Healey IRF and with the technical help provided by Engineers Without Borders we will be able to upgrade these clinics and provide much-needed enhanced medical care to the vulnerable populations in these communities.
